## Chapter 122.

AN ACT to amend the charter of "The Harriet Lane Home for Invalid Children of Baltimore city."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the charter of "The Harriet Lane Home for Invalid Children of Baltimore city," a corporation created by certificate under the provisions of the Code of Public General Laws relating to corporations, be and the same is hereby so amended that the duration of said corporation shall be unlimited.

Duration unimited.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.

## Chapter 123.

AN ACT to authorize the Hagerstown and State Line Railroad Company to sell or lease its railroad and other property to the Western Maryland Railroad Company, or to any other railroad company whose road may connect with that of the Western Maryland Railroad Company by means of the road of the Hagerstown and State Line Railroad Company.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Hagerstown and State Line Railroad Company, incorporated under the act of the general assembly of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and forty-two, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to sell or lease its railroad and other property, when the same shall be constructed or acquired to the Western Maryland Railroad Company, or to any other railroad company whose road may connect with that of the Western Maryland Railroad Company by means of the road of the said Hagerstown and State Line Railroad Company, upon such terms as may be agreed upon between
