

new district, who shall record said names with said entries attached, on the book of registration for said new district, as qualified voters thereof.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That hereafter Clarksburg district, number two, or the second election district of Montgomery county, shall be entitled to three justices of the peace and two constables, and no more.

Three justices of the peace.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the voting place of Clarksburg district, number two, or the second election district of Montgomery county, shall still be at Clarksburg.

Voting place.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

### Chapter 126.

AN ACT to repeal sections one hundred and three, one hundred and four, one hundred and seven, one hundred and nine, one hundred and eleven, one hundred and twelve, one hundred and thirteen, one hundred and eighteen, one hundred and nineteen, one hundred and twenty, one hundred and twenty-four, one hundred and twenty-five and one hundred and twenty-eight, of chapter one hundred and eight, of the acts of assembly of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws," to be entitled "Garrett county," and re-enact the same with amendments, relating to the "Corporation of Oakland."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections one hundred and three, one hundred and four, one hundred and seven, one hundred and nine, one hundred and eleven, one hundred and twelve, one hundred and thirteen, one hundred and eighteen, one hundred and nineteen, one hundred and twenty, one hundred and twenty-four,
