

the bond of such collector shall be the same as hereinbefore provided in section one hundred and twenty-three, conditioned that he shall account to the burgess and commissioners monthly for all moneys collected by him on account of said corporation, and shall pay out the same upon their order, or to the treasurer of said town, and in accordance with the ordinances of said corporation.

Chapter 127.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Governor to appoint an additional Justice of the Peace in the Seventh Election District of Queen Anne's county.

Appoint additional justice.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint an additional justice of the peace in and for the seventh election district in Queen Anne's county, in addition to those now required to be appointed by existing laws.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.

Chapter 128.

AN ACT to repeal section eighty-four, article seventy-five, title "Pleading, Practice and Process," sub-title "Process of the Code of Public General Laws," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
