

Company, represented in person, or by proxy, at a general or special meeting to be convened as provided by law.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said Western Maryland Tidewater Railroad Company, or such other company as may at any time hereafter maintain and manage said road, shall be required to run between the Howardville station, a connection with the Western Maryland Railroad and the central city station of such managing road, not less than two passenger trains per day each way, one in the forenoon between the hours of seven and eleven o'clock, and one in the afternoon between the hours of two and seven o'clock; such trains to go between said stations over the Gwynn's Falls road, and to be required to stop for passengers at Windsor, Calverton, Wetheredsville, and all crossings of other railroads, either steam or horse.

Chapter 130.

AN ACT to add a new section to article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," providing for the punishment of incest.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the following section be added to article thirty of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," to come in after section seventy-two, and to be called section seventy-three:

Section added.

73. Every person who shall knowingly have carnal knowledge of another person, being within the degrees of consanguinity within which marriages are prohibited by law in this State, shall be deemed guilty of felony, and upon indictment therefor and conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary for a term not less than one nor more than ten years, in the discretion of the court.
