SEC. 8. Be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to interfere with the rights and privileges of physicians and surgeons in the discharge of their professional duties.

Chapter 151.

AN ACT to authorize the Peoples Railway Company to purchase or lease the lines of other passenger railway companies of Baltimore city or county, or within said limits, to aid any other such railroad company in the construction of its road by subscription to its capital stock or otherwise.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Peoples Railway Company, a corporation duly incorporated under the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and forty-two, for the construction and operation of a passenger railway in Baltimore city and county, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to lease or purchase all or any part of any street passenger railroad constructed by any other railway company within the limits of Baltimore city or county, and to aid in the construction of such railroad within the limits aforesaid, by any other company, by means of subscription to the capital stock of such company or otherwise.

Lease or purchase other passenger rail-ways.
