

shall annually levy upon the assessable property of said county a tax sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds and the principal of such portion as may mature in each and every year after the date of their issue, and said levy shall be designated as "school fund."

Bonds—how redeemed.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the proceeds arising from the sale of the aforementioned bonds shall be paid over by the county commissioners to the treasurer of the board of school commissioners of said county, who shall immediately apply said proceeds to the payment of the aforesaid indebtedness now due by said school commissioners, and to no other purpose.

Bonds—proceeds—how applied.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That all laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

Inconsistencies repealed.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect and be in force from the date of its passage.

Chapter 157.

AN ACT to prevent the spread of Infectious or Contagious Diseases among the live stock of this state.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall be the duty of the governor of the state to take measures to promptly suppress any contagious or infectious disease which may make its appearance among the live stock of this state, and to prevent it from spreading.

Suppress contagious disease

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That for such purpose the governor shall appoint a veterinary inspector, who shall be a graduate in good standing of some recognised school of veterinary medicine, who shall hold his office and be paid a salary not exceeding one thousand dollars and traveling expenses, in the discretion of the governor, whose duty it shall be to visit the stables of the city and counties wherever he has reason to believe contagious or infectious diseases may exist,
