and he may visit any such stable, at any such hour of the day, between sunrise and sunset, and shall have power, with the consent of the governor, to order all

animals which have been exposed to such contagion or infection to be secluded in such manner as the nature thereof may, in his judgment, render necessary to prevent the spreading of such disease; to order that any premises, farm or farms, stables or railway cars, where such disease exists, or has existed, be put in quarantine, so that no domestic animal shall be removed from, or brought to the premises or places so quarantined until the same shall have been properly disinfected; to prescribe such regulations as he may judge necessary or expedient to prevent infection or contagion being communicated in any way from the places so quarantined; to call upon all sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, constables, policemen, or any officers of the state, the city of Baltimore, or of any county, for information and assistance to carry out and enforce the provisions of such orders and regulations; to prescribe regulations for the destruction of animals effected with infections and contagious diseases, and for the proper destruction of their hides and carcasses, and of all objects which might carry infection or contagion; provided that no animal shall be destroyed unless first examined by such veterinary inspector; to prescribe regulations for the disinfection of all premises, buildings and railway cars, and of all objects from which, or by which, infection or contagion may take place, or be conveyed; to alter and modify from time to time, as he may deem expedient, the terms of all such orders and regulations, and to cancel or withdraw the same at any time; to order all or any animals coming into the state to be detained at any place or places for the purpose of inspection and examination which he may suspect to be affected with contagious or infectious diseases; provided, that animals coming from a neighboring state that have been quarantined and discharged, shall not be subject to the provisions of this act; and it shall be the duty of all sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, constables, policemen, or other officers

of the state, city of Baltimore or counties, to obey and observe all orders and instructions which they may receive from the said veterinary inspector in the enforcement of the provisions of this act within their

respective jurisdictions.
