

Chapter 23.

AN ACT to amend article thirty-seven of the Code of Public General Laws by adding thereto a section to be numbered section sixty, to dispense with exemplified copies of records in certain causes in the city of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That article thirty-seven of the Code of Public General Laws be amended by adding thereto a section, to be numbered section sixty, as follows:

Additional section.

SEC. 60. In any suit now depending, or hereafter to depend, in any court in the city of Baltimore, wherein a transcript of the record of any cause in any other court in the city of Baltimore might be offered in evidence, it shall be sufficient to produce the docket entries and original papers and proceedings in said last mentioned cause, or the record book in which the same have been recorded, if required by law to be recorded and actually recorded, and offer the same in evidence; and the same, when so produced and offered in evidence, shall have the same effect, to all intents and purposes, as a transcript of the record thereof under the seal of the court wherein the same are; and such production may be had by any party to a suit upon a subpoena duces tecum issued to the clerk of the court wherein such docket entries, original papers and proceedings may be.
