## Chapter 173.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Commissioners of Wicomico county to appropriate, in their discretion, a sum of money to aid in the repairing and improving of the streets of the town of Salisbury.

Commissioners authorized to appropriate.

Levy on assessable property.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the county commissioners of Wicomico county be and they are authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to appropriate in each and every year the sum of five hundred dollars, for the purpose of improving and repairing the streets of the town of Salisbury in said county.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to levy a tax of five hundred dollars, in each and every year, on the assessable property of the county aforesaid, to and for the use of the commissioners of Salisbury in said county, to be used by them for the improving and repairing of the streets as aforesaid.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
