

Chapter 174.

AN ACT to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the devise and bequest to Reverend H. G. Bowers, contained in the last will and testament of George Richards, late of Frederick county, deceased.

WHEREAS George Richards, late of Frederick county, deceased, did, by his last will and testament, recorded in liber J. P. P., number one, folio four hundred and twenty-five, &c., one of the testamentary records of Frederick county, bequeath and devise the rest and residue of his estate to the Reverend H. G. Bowers, of Jefferson, Maryland, expressing therein the devise that he use and appropriate the same for such religious and charitable purposes and objects, and in such sums and in such manner, as will in his judgment best promote the cause of Christ; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and assent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and is hereby given to the said devise and bequest of George Richards, deceased, contained in his last will and testament, recorded in the office of the register of wills of Frederick county, in liber J. P. P., number one, folio four hundred and twenty-five, &c., one of the record books of wills of said county, of the rest and residue of his estate, to the Reverend H. G. Bowers.

Sanction and assent given.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
