## Chapter 24.

AN ACT to repeal section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-two of the acts of the General Assembly, passed February 21, 1843, entitled "A supplement to an act to incorporate the Fredericktown Savings Institution," and to re-enact the said section so it shall read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

Number of directors.

Effective.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section one of chapter one hundred and twenty-two of the acts of the General Assembly passed February 21, 1843, entitled "A supplement to an act to incorporate the Fredericktown Savings Institution," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Board of Directors of the Fredericktown Savings Institution shall hereafter consist of nine members, to be annually elected as provided in

the act of incorporation.

Sec. 2. Be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

## Chapter 25.

AN ACT to repeal article thirty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crows," so far as the same relates to Baltimore county.

How far repealed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That article thirty-one of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Crows," be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same relates to Baltimore county.
