Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That if it shall appear by the returns of said judges of election, and the certificate of the clerk of said court, that a majority of the votes cast at said election, in any election district in said county, has been cast against the sale of intoxicating liquors, then it shall not be lawful for any person or persons, house, corporation, company or association, to sell directly or indirectly at any place, or to give away at his, her, their or its place of business, any spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors, of whatever origin, or alcoholic bitters, in any election district of said county wherein a majority of the votes has thus been cast against the sale of intoxicating liquors, nor shall any license be issued or granted for the sale of the same in any of said election districts of said county, on or after the first day of May, in the

year eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That if it shall appear

by the returns of said judges of election and certificate of the elerk of said court that a majority of all the votes cast at said election in said Garrett county has been cast against the sale of intoxicating liquors, then it shall not be lawful for any person or persons, house, corporation, company or association to sell directly or indirectly at any place in said county, or to give away at his, her, their or its place of business, any spirituous, fermented or intoxicating liquors, of whatever origin, or alcoholic bitters, nor shall any license be issued or granted for the sale of the same in said county on or after the first day of May, in the year

eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons, house, company, corporation or association, or body corporate, shall sell directly or indirectly at any place, or give away at his, her, their or its place of business, any spirituous or fermented or alcoholic bitters, or intoxicating drinks of any kind, within the limits of any of said election districts wherein a majority of the votes has been thus cast against the sale of intoxicating liquors, on or after the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five; or in case it shall appear by said returns and said certificate of said clerk, that a majority of all the votes cast in said county, at said election, has been cast against the sale of intoxicating liquors, if any person or persons, house, company, association, corporation or
