

Chapter 187.

AN ACT to repeal section eight hundred and twenty-seven, Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore, sub-title "Police," chapter one hundred and seventy-eight, of the acts of assembly passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to repeal section eight hundred and twenty-seven, chapter four hundred and seventy-three, of the acts of assembly passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy," entitled "An act to add an additional section to article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Police,'" and be section eight hundred and twenty-seven of said article, and to amend and re-enact the same as amended.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section eight hundred and twenty-seven of article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Police," being chapter one hundred and seventy-eight of the acts of assembly passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, be and the same is hereby repealed, amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Repealed and re-enacted.

827. Whenever any person shall be arrested in the city of Baltimore, charged with any crime or misdemeanor, or for being drunk or disorderly, or for any breach of the peace, and shall be taken before any of the police justices of the peace of the said city, and any such person shall be found to have concealed about his person any pistol, dirk-knife, bowie-knife, sling-shot, billy, brass, iron or any other metal knuckles, razor, or any other deadly weapon whatsoever, such person shall be subject to a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars, in the discretion of the police justice of the peace before whom such person may be taken, and the confiscation of the weapon so found, which said fine shall be collected as other fines are now collected; provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to those persons who, as conservators of the peace, are entitled or
