

Chapter 193.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the Mayor and Common Council of Westminster, Carroll county, Maryland, to agree and contract with the President and Managers of the Baltimore and Reisterstown Turnpike Company, for the use and control of its turnpike road through the city of Westminster, in Carroll county, Maryland.

Agree and
contract.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the mayor and common council of Westminster be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to agree and contract with the president and managers of the Baltimore and Reisterstown Turnpike Company, for the use and control, or purchase of so much of the road of said turnpike company as passed through the city of Westminster, in Carroll county, Maryland, or as much thereof as may be agreed upon, and upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by and between the parties aforesaid, for use as a public highway.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 194.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest to the Second Reformed Church of Hagerstown, Washington county, contained in the last will and testament of Ann Margaretta Hellane, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland, be and the same is hereby given to the bequest of one hundred dollars to the Second Reformed church, of Hagerstown, Washington county,
