

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said mayor and city council of Baltimore shall annually levy a tax upon all the real and personal property of said corporation, sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds, or any part thereof, which may be issued as it shall become due; and the said mayor and city council of Baltimore shall also levy an annual tax upon the property aforesaid each year, which shall in the aggregate, in twenty years from the date of issuing said bonds, be sufficient to pay the principal sum of said bonds which shall have been issued as above provided.

Levy tax annually.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 201.

AN ACT to provide for an additional Constable in election district number eight, Carroll county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the county commissioners of Carroll county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to appoint an additional constable in election district number eight, Carroll county, who shall reside at Hampsted.

Appoint additional constable

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
