

**Chapter 204.**

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to refurnish the Comptroller's office with suitable desks and the necessary cases requisite for the proper preservation of the books and papers in said office, and for carpeting the same.

WHEREAS the cases for the preservation of books and papers of the comptroller's office are utterly inadequate for that purpose, and the desks, with but one single exception, are worthless, the office being sadly in need of refurnishing; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller of the treasury be and is hereby authorized to have the said office refurnished with the book-cases necessary for the proper preservation of books and papers, and with desks suitable for said office, and also have said office properly carpeted and refitted.

Refurnish office.

SEC 2. *Be it enacted,* That the sum of one thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.

Appropriation therefor.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
