

if this charter had not been granted; and the commissioners for Montgomery county shall appropriate annually one-half of the tax levied or imposed upon the assessable property within the corporate limits of the town, and shall order the county collectors, who shall collect the taxes within said corporate limits, to pay said one-half thereof to the commissioners of said town for that purpose.

SEC. 27. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners shall have power to establish building lines on all the streets in said town, or which shall hereafter be opened therein, and to compel all persons hereafter erecting buildings in said town to conform thereto.

Establish building lines.

SEC. 28. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 209.

AN ACT to protect Game and Birds in Frederick county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons hereafter to sell, barter or trade, or attempt to sell, barter or trade, any pheasants, partridges, squirrels or woodcock, that have been taken, trapped, snared or shot in Frederick county.

What it is unlawful to sell, &c.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted*, That it shall not be lawful for any one to hire, or employ any one, to shoot, take, trap or snare any pheasants, partridges, squirrels or woodcock in Frederick county; nor shall it be lawful for any one to enter into any bargain or engagement of any kind, by which any profit or advantage is to be derived to either party, for shooting, taking, trapping or snaring any pheasants, partridges, squirrels or woodcock in Frederick county.

Unlawful to shoot pheasants, &c.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted*, That it shall not be lawful for any one to ship, attempt to ship, to any place beyond the limits of Frederick county, or to sell to
