

Chapter 216.

AN ACT to pay to J. Harris Forbes the sum of three hundred dollars for clerical services rendered in the office of the State Treasurer.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer of the state for the sum of three hundred dollars, in favor of J. Harris Forbes, for clerical services rendered in the treasurer's office in connection with the exchange and redemption of the defence loan.

Authorized to draw warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 217.

AN ACT to give and declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest of five hundred dollars contained in the last will and testament of Charles S. Parran, late of Calvert county, Maryland, deceased, to the vestry of St. Paul's Parish, at Prince Frederick, in Calvert county, State of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same are hereby given and declared to the bequest of five hundred dollars contained in the last will and testament of Charles S. Parran, late of Calvert county, deceased, to the vestry of St. Paul's Parish, at Prince Frederick, in Calvert county, State of Maryland.

Sanction and consent given to bequest.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
