Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That its sanction be and the same is hereby given to the bequest of one hundred dollars for the purchase of a library for the Sabbath-school to the Reformed Church at Utica Mills, in Frederick county, Maryland, contained in the last will and testament of Elizabeth Hiteshew, of Frederick county, deceased.
