

**Chapter 222.**

AN ACT to declare the sanction of the General Assembly to the bequest of Rachel Wilson, late of Harford county, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sanction of the general assembly be and the same is hereby given to the following bequest, given under the last will and testament of Rachel Wilson, late of Harford county, deceased, said will being of record in the office of the register of wills of Harford county, to wit: One thousand dollars to the superannuated fund of the Maryland Annual Conference of the Methodist Protestant Church, and one thousand dollars to the home mission of the Maryland Annual Conference of the Methodist Protestant Church.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 223.**

AN ACT to give and declare the consent and sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the devise and bequest of Rebecca V. Gooding, late of the city of Baltimore, deceased, to the Bond Street Methodist Episcopal Church South, in Baltimore city, to be paid on the debt of the church.

WHEREAS Rebecca V. Gooding, late of the city of Baltimore, deceased, by her last will and testament, duly admitted to probate in the orphans' court of Baltimore city, on or about the sixth day of September, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, and duly recorded in the office of the register of wills of Baltimore city, in Wills Liber R. T. B, number fifty, folio one hundred and forty-one, and devised certain real estate, situated in Chestervill, Kent county, and certain lease-
