Chapter 224.

AN ACT to prevent stock running at large in district number twelve, or Williamsburg, and in that part of district number one, or Fork, lying on the east side of the northwest fork of the Nanticoke river, in Dorchester county.

Stock not to go at large.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for stock of any kind to go at large, without attendants, in district number twelve, or Williamsburg, or in that part of district number one, or Fork, lying on the east side of the northwest fork of the Nanticoke river, in Dorchester county.

Constable to take up.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be lawful for any person, and the duty of any constable of said district number twelve, or Williamsburg, and of district number one, or Fork, to take up any horse, mare or gelding, mule, horned cattle, swine or other stock which may be found running at large, and without attendants, in said Williamsburg district, or in that part of the Fork district specified in this act; and the person or constable so taking up any such stock, shall impound the same; and if taken up by a constable, he shall give notice of said impounding, by advertisement in at least two public places, by either written or printed notice, posted within the district or part of district wherein said stock are taken, describing the stock so impounded; and he shall proceed to sell said
