Chapter 229.

AN ACT to repeal section ten of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the act passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to establish the Maryland House of Correction."

Effective.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section ten of chapter two hundred and thirty-three of the acts passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, entitled "An act to establish the Maryland House of Correction," be and the same is hereby repealed so far as it applies to Frederick county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall go into effect from the date of its passage, and that all acts or parts of acts inconsistent therewith be and the

same are hereby repealed.

Chapter 230.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section seven hundred and ninety-three, article four, Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Navigation."

Repealed and re-enacted. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section seven hundred and ninety-three of article four of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Navigation," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows, namely:

SEC. 793. The mayor and city council shall have power to provide for the preservation of the navigation of the basin and Patapsco river within the limits of the city, and within four miles thereof, including the establishment of lines outside the limits of the

Navigation of the Patapsco.
