

and eighty-two, to examine the condition of the oyster beds of this state and report to this general assembly, and the sum of one hundred and fifty-six dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay William K. Brooks for similar expenses incurred under like appointment and service as commissioner appointed under said resolution, and the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars and twenty-five cents be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay William H. Legg for similar expenses incurred under like appointment and service as commissioner appointed under said resolution, and the comptroller of the state treasury is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for the sum of three hundred and seven dollars and seventy cents, payable out of any money to the credit of the oyster funds in the treasury, to the order of said James I. Waddell, and to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for the sum of one hundred and fifty-six dollars, payable out of any money to the credit of the oyster funds in the treasury, to the order of the said William K. Brooks, and also to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars and twenty-five cents, payable out of any money to the credit of the oyster funds in the treasury, to the order of the said William H. Legg.

Issue warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the comptroller of the treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer in favor of each of said commissioners for the sum of five hundred dollars for salary as such commissioners, as provided in the said joint resolution.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
