

**Chapter 236.**

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-five of article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard county," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and  
re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-five of article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard county," sub-title "Justices of the peace and constables" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

How many jus-  
tices &c.

25. There shall be the following number of justices of the peace and constables in said county, to wit: For election district number one, four justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number two, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number three, four justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number four, three justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number five, four justices of the peace and two constables; for election district number six, four justices of the peace and two constables.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 237.**

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to Charlotte Hall School, in Saint Mary's county, in this state.

Sum appropri-  
ated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of one thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the use and benefit of Charlotte Hall School, in Saint Mary's county, in this state, and that said appropriation shall continue for five consecutive years.
