payable to the "Commissioners of Charities and Corrections," in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned as follows, to wit: "The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound A. B., as overseer or keeper of the alms or poor house in Frederick county, and manager of the farm connected therewith, shall well and truly discharge his duties in said station, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law."

Sec. 14. They shall, in January in each year, appoint one of their own members treasurer of the commissioners of charities and corrections of Frederick county, who shall collect and receive all moneys appropriated for the use and benefit of the almshouse, and for the support and maintenance of persons committed to the jail of Frederick county, by the county commissioners of said county, and all sums of money arising from the sale of the products raised on the farm connected with the almshouse, or due and owing to said commissioners of charities and corrections from any other source.

SEC. 15. The said treasurer, before entering upon the discharge of his duties, shall execute a bond payable to the said commissioners of charities and corrections, with sufficient securities approved by them in the penal sum of ten thousand dollars, conditioned as follows, to wit: "The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound A. B. shall well and faithfully discharge the duties of treasurer of the commissioners of charities and corrections of Frederick county, and shall well and faithfully account for all moneys that shall come into his hands as treasurer, and pay over the said moneys to the person or persons legally authorized to receive the same, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law."

Bond.

SEC. 16. The said treasurer shall not pay out any of the funds that shall come into his hands, unless by written order of said commissioners of charities and corrections.

SEC. 17. He shall render to the commissioners of charities and corrections at their last meeting in each year, a statement of his accounts, under oath, and all accounts settled by the treasurer or overseer of the almshouse, with the commissioners of charities and corrections, shall be on oath that they are just and
