full schedule or statement of all persons committed to said jail, showing the length of time for which they are committed, the offence for which they are committed, and the name of the officer by whom committed, which schedule or statement shall at all times be open to the inspection of said commissioners of charities and corrections, or either of them. For any neglect by the sheriff to comply with any provision of this section he shall be liable to the fine prescribed in section thirty-three of this article.

Penalty.

Disposition of

SEC. 35. It shall be the duty of said commissioners of charities and corrections, should any balance remain in their hands at the end of any year over and above the expenditures for that year, to deduct such balance from the estimate for the succeeding year, and to make requisition on the county commissioners only for the balance; and it shall likewise be their duty to keep the several accounts for the jail and almshouse separate and distinct, and to submit in their annual report to the county commissioners separate statements respecting the receipts and disbursements on account of said jail and said almshouse.

Submit report.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 243.

AN ACT to repeal the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and ninety-three, entitled "An act for the protection of Dairymen, and to prevent deception in the sale of Butter and Cheese, and to re-enact new sections in lieu thereof.

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter four hundred and ninety-three, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following sections enacted in lieu thereof.
