Chapter 245.

AN ACT to refund to William A. Lyon, late collector of Taxes for the fourth election district of St. Mary's county, the sum of forty-nine dollars and thirty-nine cents, for money paid into the Treasury of the State in excess of the amounts due by him for State Taxes for eighteen hundred and eighty and eighteen hundred and eighty-one.

Issue warrant. SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer for forty-nine dollars and thirty-nine cents, to pay William A. Lyon, for money paid by him into the treasury, as collector of taxes for the fourth district of St. Mary's county, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty and eighteen hundred and eighty-one, in excess of the amount due by him as collector aforesaid.

Chapter 246.

AN ACT to authorize the Delaware, Maryland and Virginia Railroad Company to extend its railroad.

Construct branch roads. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Delaware, Maryland and Virginia Railroad Company shall be and it is empowered to locate, construct and operate branch railroads from
