

**Chapter 34.**

AN ACT to direct the County Commissioners of Baltimore County to levy a sum of money for the use of John Swan, of Baltimore county, for taxes paid by him in error.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the county commissioners of Baltimore county be and they are hereby directed, at the time of making their next annual levy, to levy for the use of John Swan, of Baltimore county, the sum of two hundred and ninety-nine dollars and ninety-three cents as taxes paid in error.

Levy for taxes paid in error.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 35.**

AN ACT to prevent the trespass upon private property in Calvert county, in this state, by any person or persons who have been forbidden to do so by a special written notice, served upon him, her or them by the owner or owners of said private property, or by their agents.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That any person or persons who shall enter upon or cross over the premises or private property of any person or persons in Calvert county, in this state, after having had a special written notice served upon him, her or them by the owner or owners of said property, or by his, her or their agent, not to cross over or enter upon said premises or private property, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof before some justice of the peace of said county, be fined by said justice not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars, and, in default of the payment of said fine, together with the cost of
