

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 259.

AN ACT to create a new election district in St. Mary's county, to be known as the Island District or Election District number nine, and to designate a voting place therefor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new election district be formed out of St. George's island, a part of the Factory district, or election district number two, of St. Mary's county, to be known as the Island district, or election district number nine of said county.

SEC 2. *And be it enacted*, That the place of holding elections in said Island district or district number nine, shall be at Adam's store in said district.

SEC 3. *And be it enacted*, That the governor shall, by and with the advice and consent of the senate, appoint one justice of the peace and one registration officer for said Island district; and the county commissioners shall appoint one constable for said district.

SEC 4. *And be it enacted*, That the clerk of the circuit court for St. Mary's county shall furnish a proper book for registration of voters, in said Island district, and that it shall be the duty of the registrar of voters for Factory district, or election district number two, and the registrar for said Island district, to transfer from the book of registration of said Factory district the names of all voters registered therein, who live in the said Island district, to the book provided for said Island district, and to strike off same from registration book of Factory district and note them as transferred, and said transfer shall have all the effect in law as if said voters had been originally registered in said Island district.
