

tioners of said county for moneys paid him under this act for their use, and that he shall make a quarterly return of same to said commissioners in the same manner and at the same time as he makes return for moneys paid for the use of the state; and if the said clerk shall fail to pay over the same within thirty days after said return, then his bond may be put in suit to recover same by the said school commissioners.

SEC. 19. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 20. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall go into and take effect on the first day of May, eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Chapter 271.

AN ACT to repeal chapter one hundred and thirty-five of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to amend the first section of an act passed at the present session of the General Assembly, entitled 'An act to provide for the uniform registration of the names of all the qualified voters in this state,' by adding thereto a sub-section, to be designated as sub-section one A, specially providing for the appointment of Officers of Registration in the Counties of this State, after the year eighteen hundred and eighty-three," and to re-enact the same with amendments providing for the transfer of registered voters on the creation of new districts.
