shore on said waters, unless so placed by the owner or

owners of such fishing shore.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That any person violating the provisions of this act shall forfeit the seine or nets, and the boat and materials used in fishing the seine, and shall, in addition, pay a fine of twenty dollars; provided, however, that the using of any post or Penalty for viostake of a larger size than four inches in the largest part, or permitting the same to remain for a longer period that ten days after the removal of the seine or nets therefrom, shall subject the person or persons so offending to a fine of not more than twenty nor less than ten dollars.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of Inconsistencies acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are repealed. hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.

## Chapter 279.

AN ACT to pay to L. F. Colton & Co. the sum of four hundred dollars for printing and binding one thousand copies of the Report of the State Tax Commissioner to the present General Assembly of Maryland.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of four hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay L. F. Colton & Co. for printing and binding one thousand Appropriation. copies of the report of the state tax commissioner to the present General Assembly of Maryland, and the treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same upon the warrant of the comptroller.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.
