Chapter 284.

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of Washington county to adjust and pay to the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown a sum of money, advanced by the said Mayor and Council, for the suppression and prevention of small-pox in Washington county.

Whereas the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown did, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, pay out and expend a certain sum of money for the erection of a small-pox hospital on the grounds of the county almshouse, which said hospital was intended for the treatment of small-pox cases of said county, and did further expend a sum of money in the care, maintenance and treatment of indigent small-pox cases of the county; therefore—

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Washington county are authorized to adjust the said claim with the mayor and council of Hagerstown, and to levy on the assessable property of the county a sum sufficient to pay the same.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 285.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-two of article eleven of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact," subtitle "State's Attorneys," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
