

Chapter 284.

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioners of Washington county to adjust and pay to the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown a sum of money, advanced by the said Mayor and Council, for the suppression and prevention of small-pox in Washington county.

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown did, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, pay out and expend a certain sum of money for the erection of a small-pox hospital on the grounds of the county almshouse, which said hospital was intended for the treatment of small-pox cases of said county, and did further expend a sum of money in the care, maintenance and treatment of indigent small-pox cases of the county; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the commissioners of Washington county are authorized to adjust the said claim with the mayor and council of Hagerstown, and to levy on the assessable property of the county a sum sufficient to pay the same.

Commissioners to adjust.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 285.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-two of article eleven of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact," sub-title "State's Attorneys," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section twenty-two of article eleven of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Attorneys at law and attorneys in fact," sub-title "State's attorneys," be and the same is hereby re-
