**Chapter 286.**

AN ACT to provide for the removal of the Boilers of the Heating Apparatus from the State House to the cellar of the Record Office.

WHEREAS, under an order passed by the house of delegates, certain bids have been received for the removal of the boilers of the heating apparatus from the state house to the record office building; and whereas it is the sense of the General Assembly that this work should be done at an early day; therefore—

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the board of public works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to contract with some suitable and competent person or persons to remove the said boilers of the heating apparatus from the state house, and place them in the cellar of the record office building, and to do all the work and to furnish all the material necessary to completely provide for the successful heating by said boilers of the state house and the said record office building, and for this purpose the sum of thirty-four hundred and fifty dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated, and the said board of public works is hereby directed to carefully supervise the said work; and after its successful completion, upon the certificate of the said board of public works, the comptroller is authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer, and the treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay the sum certified to be due to the person or persons doing the said work, provided the same does not exceed the sum hereby appropriated.
