destroy such scalp or bill, so as to prevent a second allowance for the same.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That upon the production of such certificate the county commissioners of Calvert county are hereby authorized and directed to levy upon the assessable property of said county a taxes. sum sufficient for the aforesaid bounty, for use of the person or persons producing the same, and the collectors of taxes shall collect and pay the same accordingly.

Levy sufficient

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That no justice of the peace shall be entitled to any fee or reward for the titled to fee. taking of such oath or the issuing such certificate.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the aforegoing sections shall not be so construed as to include any fishhawk.

How construed

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 42.

AN ACT to determine the standard measure and weight of charcoal.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the standard measure of charcoal shall be two thousand seven hundred and forty-eight ure of charcoal. cubic inches for each and every bushel thereof, and, when sold by weight, a bushel shall be twenty pounds (commercially dry).

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That all other acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall take Effective. effect from the date of its passage.
