general measurer shall act the second time in any district until he has acted once in every other district.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 300.

AN ACT to prohibit reckless shooting along the Public roads of Montgomery county, the Penalty therefor, and how recovered.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any person who shall recklessly shoot along any public road or highway, or on the streets of any town or village in Montgomery county, thereby causing injury to persons, stock or vehicles, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before a justice of the peace shall, at the discretion of the said justice of the peace, be subject to a fine of not less than five dollars and costs for each offence; the fine to be doubled in every instance if the offence be committed in the night, or on Sunday, the offender to be committed to the county jail until such fines and costs are paid, or until discharged by due process of law.

Reckless shooting prohibited.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
