

Chapter 311.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section sixteen, class three of article twenty-six, title "Corporations," of the Code of Public General Laws.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section sixteen, class three of article twenty-six, title "Corporations," of the Code of Public General Laws, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 16. CLASS 3. For buying, selling, mortgaging, leasing, improving, disposing of or otherwise dealing with lands in this state or partly in this state, or partly in this state and partly beyond this state, and for the procuring and preparing for market transportation and selling of lumber, timber, wood, trees, plants, seeds, fruits, roots or other products of land.

Chapter 312.

AN ACT to repeal chapter four hundred and nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to enable the mayor and city council of Baltimore city to appropriate money for the relief of disabled and superannuated firemen, and members of the police force of Baltimore city," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter four hundred and nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to enable the mayor and city council of Baltimore city to appropriate money for the relief of disabled and superannuated firemen, and members of the police force of Baltimore city," be and the same is
