Chapter 313.

AN ACT to repeal section nineteen of chapter four hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of assembly passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to repeal sections eighteen and nineteen of article eighteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Clerks of Courts,'" and re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section nineteen of chapter four hundred and sixty-nine of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to sections eighteen and nineteen of article eighteen of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Clerks of Courts,'" be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Clerk guilty of misdemeanor.

SEC. 19. If any clerk shall neglect or refuse to comply with the provisions of the three preceding sections he shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall forfeit the sum of two hundred dollars for the use of the state; provided that, so far as the proceedings mentioned in section eighteen are concerned, the clerk shall not be required to record the same until the costs thereof shall have been first paid; provided that this act shall not be held to apply to Anne Arundel, Howard and Worcester counties.
