

together with all improvements thereon erected within the bounds thereof, belonging to the United States, shall be exempted, exonerated and discharged from all state, county and municipal taxation, so long as the said lot shall remain the property of the United States of America for the purposes aforesaid.

Chapter 322.

AN ACT to repeal section one of chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to protect diamond-back terrapins in the waters of the State of Maryland, and to regulate the catching of the same;" so far as it relates to Dorchester county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one of chapter four hundred and twenty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy eight, entitled "An act to protect diamond-back terrapins in the waters of Maryland, and to regulate the catching of the same" be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same relates to Dorchester county, and the following enacted in lieu thereof.

Section repealed.

Enacted in lieu

1. Hereafter it shall be unlawful for any person to take or catch diamond-back terrapins from the waters of Dorchester county, between the first day of June and the first day of September in each year.

Unlawful.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
