

or signalman to warn persons using said turnpike in crossing over said railroad of the approach of trains upon said railroad.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Frederick and Pennsylvania Line Railroad Company shall be liable to pay a fine of one hundred dollars for each day that said company shall refuse or neglect to comply with the provisions of this act, to be recovered in an action of debt, in the name of the State of Maryland, before any justice of the peace of said Frederick county, one-half of said fine to go to the informer, and the other half for the use of the school commissioners of Frederick county.

### Chapter 332.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," to be known as sub-section twenty-nine A, under the sub-title of "Jail."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That an additional section be added to article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester county," to be known as sub-section twenty-nine A, under the sub-title of "Jail."

Section added.

SEC. 29 A. *And be it enacted*, That the county commissioners, after the passage of this act, and every two years thereafter, shall appoint a non-partizan board of five discreet male persons, voters and residents of the town of Cambridge, to act as jail supervisors; that the said jail supervisors shall serve without compensation, for the term of two years, and until their successors shall have been appointed and qualified; they shall have supervision and control of the jail and adjoining grounds, with the right of visiting and inspecting the same at any and all times, subject to the review and ratification of the commissioners; they shall pass and enforce all necessary rules for the protection of the health, cleanliness and com-
