

**Chapter 335.**

AN ACT to repeal section four of chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the session of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "An act to repeal and re-enact with amendments an act entitled 'An act to incorporate the Corn and Flour Exchange of the city of Baltimore,' passed March twenty-third, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter eighty-three," and re-enact the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section four of chapter one hundred and thirty-six of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the session of eighteen hundred and seventy, entitled "An act to incorporate the Corn and Flour Exchange of the city of Baltimore, passed March twenty-third, eighteen hundred and sixty-five, chapter eighty-three," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

4. Said corporation shall have the power to prescribe and regulate, by such by-laws as it may see fit to adopt, the qualifications of its members and all matters and things relating to their admission, rejection, suspension and exclusion; no person shall be entitled to the privileges of membership except in conformity with such by-laws, unless he shall have first signed a copy of the constitution and by-laws of said corporation.
