Chapter 344.

AN ACT to repeal sections one, two and three of chapter three hundred and seventy-seven of the acts passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled "An act to change the dividing lines between the sixth and seventh election districts of Worcester county," and to reenact the same as follows:

Repealed and re-cuacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections one, two and three of an act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and eighty two, chapter three hundred and seventy-seven, entitled "An act to change the dividing lines between the sixth and seventh election districts of Worcester county" be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

1. That the dividing line between the sixth and seventh election districts of Worcester county, shall run as follows: beginning at Nassawanga bridge; thence running with the said creek to the Furnace Mill-pond; thence with said mill pond until it intersects Sandy Branch; thence by and with Sandy Branch until it intersects the county road leading from the Furnace Mill-pond to Salisbury; thence by and with said county road until it strikes the line of Wicomico county.

2. That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with

this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

3. That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
