Penalty for violation.

SEC. 3½. *And be it enacted*, That any person who shall violate this act in selling spirituous or fermented liquors in any election district in Talbot county, where the majority has been cast against such sale, on conviction thereof shall be fined not less than fifty nor more than three hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the House of Correction for not less than three months nor more than six months, in the discretion of the court, for each and every offence.

**Chapter 347.**

AN ACT to require the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company to keep a flagman at the crossing of Second street and the tracks of said company in the town of Oakland, in Garrett county.

Flagman at crossing.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company shall keep a flagman to guard the crossing of the tracks of said company over second street in the town of Oakland, Garrett county, between the hours of seven a. m. and nine p. m. daily, except Sunday.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
