

appropriated for the payment of expenses and of the fees of said counsel, to be determined by the governor and attorney general, and on the certificate of the governor and attorney general, the comptroller shall issue his warrant on the treasurer for the same or any part thereof, and the treasurer shall pay the same out of any funds, not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 355.

AN ACT to repeal the eighth and ninth sections of an act passed at the present session of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled "An act to incorporate the Isle of Wight Inlet and Oyster Planting Company of Worcester county," and to amend and re-enact the eighth and ninth sections of said act.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That sections eight and nine of the act passed at the present session of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled "An act to incorporate the Isle of Wight Inlet and Oyster Planting Company of Worcester county," be and the same is hereby repealed, and to amend and re-enact said sections so as to read as follows:

SEC. 8. *Be it enacted*, That in consideration of the cutting and making of the inlet aforesaid and maintaining the same, and the great advantages rendered to the adjacent land thereby, and the increased value to the State of Maryland, and to Worcester county and to citizens thereof, by the salting of the Isle of Wight and Assowoman bays by the regular ebb and flow of the tide through the inlet aforesaid, the State of Maryland does hereby convey unto the said Isle of Wight Inlet and Oyster Planting Company one-half of the beds of the said Isle of Wight and Assowoman bays, bounded and described as follows, to wit: For a centre line, commencing at a centre point in a line
