SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions hereof be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect on and after the first day of May, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Chapter 360.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-four of chapter four hundred and seventy-one of the acts of assembly, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to repeal article twenty-six of the Code of Public General Laws," and to enact a substitute therefor, and to repeal section twenty-two of article sixteen, sections ninety-nine to one hundred and three of the same article, and sections thirty-three to forty-three of article eighty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, and to re-enact said section twenty-four with amendments; also to add a new section to said act, to follow section one hundred and thirty six, and to be numbered one hundred and thirty-six A.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section twenty-four of chapter four hundred and seventy-one of the acts of assembly, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and sixty-eight, entitled "An act to repeal article twenty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, and to enact a substitute therefor, and to repeal section twenty-two or article sixteen, sections ninety-nine to one hundred and three of the same article, and sections thirty-three to forty-three of article eighty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, be and is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows, viz:
