county, and shall be filed by the clerk of said court, and shall be confirmed by said court at the term next succeeding the filing thereof with said clerk, unless sufficient cause to the contrary be shown, and when comfirmed, shall be recorded by said clerk at the cost of said corporation, and if any objections be filed to such confirmation, they shall stand for hearing within the first ten days of the first term of court after said inquisition is returned, and if said inquisition is set aside, said court may direct another inquisition to issue as is practiced in other condemnation cases.

Sec. 10. And be it enacted, That every such inquisition shall describe the property taken, and the bounds of the lands condemned, and the quantity or duration of the interest condemned for the corporation, and such valuation, when paid or tendered to the owner of said property, or his attorneys, shall entitle said corporation to the estate and property so valued as fully as if the same had been conveyed by

the owner thereof.

Sec. 11. And be it enacted. That the commissioners hereinbefore named, or a majority of them, are hereby authorized and empowered to do all acts necessary and proper to the carrying out of the provisions of this act, whether such powers are specifically herein mentioned or not, and the mayor and councilmen of said town are hereby authorized and empowered to pass all ordinances necessary or proper upon their part to the carrying out of the provisions hereof, and any corporation owning any rights, privileges, property or franchises necessary or proper to be purchased by said commissioners, in order to carry this act into effect, is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of, grant and convey, such rights, privileges, property or franchises to said commissioners for said mayor and councilmen of Frostburg.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to wilfully pollute any stream, brook, spring, reservoir, water course or other source, or means of water supply of said town, through the works so built, erected, purchased or improved by the commissioners under this act, by throwing any dead animal or other impure substance into the same, or by swimming, bathing or washing themselves, or by washing clothes or the skins of dead animals, or any other impure thing therein, or by committing

Unlawful.
