

registrar shall make no transfer of voters upon his personal knowledge, without application from such voter, after this year, and said transfer shall be confined to the division of the now registered vote of said Cambridge district, or the changing from one precinct to the other, provided that if the registrar shall fail to make the proper transfer from one precinct to the other, the voter shall be entitled to vote in the precinct where he remains duly registered.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the county commissioners of Dorchester county are hereby empowered and directed to appoint judges of election for each of said precincts, at all elections hereafter to be held.

Chapter 364.

AN ACT to repeal article twenty-eight, section fifteen, of the Code of Public General Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty, title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section fifteen of article twenty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty, title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 15. *Be it enacted*, That whenever the county commissioners shall decide that it is expedient that a road be opened as provided in the preceding section, they may contract with the owner or owners of the land through which the said road is intended to run, for the right of way over the land necessary for said road, if he, she or they be competent to contract ; and in case the said county commissioners shall so contract, they shall cause a plat of the said road to be made, by a competent surveyor, and filed and recorded in the
