## Chapter 376.

AN ACT to punish persons trespassing upon and injuring the property of others in Washington county.

Unlawful to trespass.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be unlawful for any person in Washington county to go upon the lands of another to hunt or fish thereon against the will and consent of the owner or occupant thereof; and it shall also be unlawful for any one to enter upon the lands of another and injure or carry away any grain or fruit, or tear down or injure any fence, vine, tree or wall without the consent of the owner or occupant of said lands first had and obtained; and any one who shall violate any of the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before a justice of the peace of the said county shall be fined not less than one nor more than twenty dollars and costs, and upon failure to pay the same he shall be confined in the county jail for a period not exceeding thirty days, or until the fine and costs are paid, whichever shall first occur; one half of said fine to go to the informer and the other half to the school commissioners of said county for the benefit of the school fund of said county.

## Chapter 377.

AN ACT to appropriate a certain sum of money for the use of the Harbor and River Relief Board of Baltimore city.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the comptroller be and he is hereby instructed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer of the state for the sum of ten thousand dollars, as an appropriation on the part of the state, for the use and service of the harbor and river relief board of Baltimore city, for the sole benefit of the ice boat Maryland.
