Chapter 378.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the claim of Daniel E. Davis.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the comptroller of the treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the treasurer to pay to Daniel E. Davis, of Annapolis, Maryland, the sum of six hundred dollars for services rendered as night watchman watchman of the buildings within the state house enclosure, for the years eighteen hundred and seventy and eighteen hundred and seventy-one, the general appropriation acts for those years having omitted to make the usual and proper appropriation for the same.

AN ACT to provide for two additional Justices of the Peace for Baltimore city.
