Chapter 385.

AN ACT to repeal sections five, six and nine of an act, entitled "An act to permit the shooting of Wild Fowl from sink boxes in the waters of the Elk and Bohemia rivers and their tributaries, in Cecil county," passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter two hundred and ninety-two, and re-enact the same so as to read as follows:

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections five, six and nine of an act, entitled "An act to permit the shooting of wild fowl from sink boxes in the waters of the Elk and Bohemia rivers and their tributaries, in Cecil county," passed January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, chapter two hundred and ninety-two be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Special police-

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That John P. Duhamel, of Cecil county be and he is hereby appointed special policeman for Elk and Bohemia rivers and their tributaries, in Cecil county, for two years from the first day of November, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four, and that after the expiration of the term of the said John P. Duhamel, and every two years thereafter, the governor with the advice and consent of the senate, shall appoint a special policeman for the said rivers and their tributaries, in Cecil county, who shall hold his office until his successor qualifies, or during the pleasure of the governor; and the special policeman appointed under this act shall, within sixty days after his appointment, file with the clerk of the circuit court for Cecil county, a bond with sureties to be approved by said clerk, in the penalty of one thousand dollars for the faithful performance of his duties under the provisions of this act; and it shall be the duty of the special policeman appointed under this act to enforce its provisions, and he shall have power to arrest without warrant upon his own view, or upon credible information all persons violating the same, and to carry such persons before any justice of the
